- 3. Inniscrone's restaurant facility will be a family-focused, fine dining establishment serving only Inniscrone's golfing members and their guests, guests at catered events, and residents of London Grove and the surrounding community.**
- 4. If a license is granted, it can never be transferred, meaning that restaurants and bars serving alcohol will not spring up in our township.**
